LEICESTER PREPARATORY SCHOOL DISABILITY ACCESS PLAN
(Revised Sept 2017)

Consideration must be given to the school's position as regards accessibility.

The school would like to be able to accommodate children with some disability but is much restricted by its building. The doorways are narrow and the corridors change width and surface covering. There are many changes of floor level (four floors and half floors with narrow/curved stairways) and very little flexibility for ramps/lifts to allow access to wheelchairs. Access from the road is stepped with little opportunity for ramped provision. The school would encourage parents to view the buildings and assess for themselves the accessibility required. Parents may be encouraged to consult the LEA and visit other schools in the area which may be better placed for particular needs.
